Center Description and Scope of Services:

17 exam rooms (soon to be expanded)

Primary medical care services including general medical care, family planning, diagnostic laboratory and limited diagnostic radiology, HIV testing and counseling, testing for blood levels, and immunizations.

Additional diagnostic radiology services and other diagnostic testing is provided by referral. Preventive care is also offered at all clinic sites. Most providers are currently participating in the Bureau of Primary Health Care's Diabetes Collaborative, which is a nationwide effort at improving outcomes of patients with chronic disease.

Obstetrical and Gynecological Care , which includes gynecological care, prenatal care, antepartum fetal assessment, and postpartum care. High-risk care, ultrasound, and labor and delivery services are provided by referral.

Dental Care services include preventive, restorative, emergency and rehabilitative care. Patients who lack adequate financial resources as well as other specially designated groups are given priority to dental care.

Pharmacy Services are offered at the Community Access Pharmacy in Des Moines and through a contracted pharmacy in Marshalltown. Patients have access to low cost prescription drugs through the 340B pharmacy program. In addition, assistance is provided to patients in procuring pharmaceutical company's patient assistance program (PAP) medications at minimal cost.

Other Professional Service are offered at all of the service delivery locations including hearing and vision screening. Occupational, vocational, physical therapy, optometry and podiatry are offered by referral. Nutrition and ophthalmology specialty services are offered via contracted providers.

Supportive Services including interpretation/translation services, transportation assistance, and environmental health risk reduction, health education, and nursing home and assisted-living referrals, are available at all locations. Additional supportive services are offered at the Outreach Project locations and include case management, eligibility assistance, outreach, home visits, and prenatal education.

Mental Health/Substance Services are offered on site at all clinic sites. In addition, the Enhancement Program of the Outreach Project provides substance abuse assessments for homeless populations and makes treatment referrals.

Current Provider Staff: 1 FTE Family Practice Physician, 0.2 FTE Pediatrician, 4.7 FTE Mid Level Providers (Family Practice, Pediatrics, & OB/GYN), Behavioral Health Services provided through contracted providers

Marshalltown Medical & Surgical Center MMSC is a not-for-profit, 501(c) (3), community hospital in Marshall County, Iowa. MMSC is a 125 bed acute care facility, with a state-of-the-art Diagnostic Imaging Department, Cardiac Catheterization Lab and Rehabilitation Center.

MMSC employees 700 health care professionals. The hospital also owns and operates four primary care medical clinics in Marshalltown, Conrad, State Center and Toledo.

More than 60,000 residents depend on MMSC for a wide variety of health care services, and around the clock emergency care, and a host of outreach programs designed to meet the healthcare needs of the community.
