Material relating to the Herman Orschel family, former patients and family friends from Livingston, Montana (later Chicago). Includes personal letters and poems from ATS and Mary Elvira Still (MES), primarily to Mrs. Orschel. According to correspondence in the files, the Orschels' daughter gave the letters Dr. S.V. Robuck (ASO 1913). He sent them in 1963 to KCOS Dean R.M. Tilley, who apparently put them into a scrapbook with other material relating to ATS.¹ The series is noteworthy for the rare personal glimpse it gives of both Stills, for whom very little correspondence has been found.
