### ST. LOUIS DENTAL EDUCATION AND ORAL HEALTH CLINIC

In partnership with Affinia Healthcare, the 79,000-square-foot, state-of-the-art facility features 93 dental chairs and a dental urgent care center to serve St. Louis area residents regardless of age, special needs, or income. The St. Louis Dental Education and Oral Health Clinic opened in 2015 near historic Lafayette Square in St. Louis, Missouri.

- » Clinical education based in St. Louis, Missouri
- » Students treat patients under the supervision of licensed dentists
- » Half of fourth-year rotations at community-based clinics, may include experiences at health centers and other safety net clinics
