

Data Use and Management Work Group releases University data sets

President Phelps established a Data Use and Management Work Group to help provide access to accurate and timely data relating to University activities. The group has been investigating sources of various data owned by the University and publicly available data, as well as those who are responsible for its accuracy.

The final outcome will be a set of University-wide data, which will be accessible both internally and externally. Information will be restricted in some cases, and all data will not be made available to external audiences.

As a part of the accreditation process, the University must demonstrate its commitment to quality improvement, and access to this data will help demonstrate our University's progress toward this goal.

Within this announcement, the University is releasing the first data set for internal use. Data is accessible from the ATSU Portal (my.atsu.edu) via Departments > Research and Sponsored Programs > Institutional Research or simply searching for "research." This will allow access to "real-time" data relating to some University activities. The data source, frequency of update, data owners, and other useful information are also available for each data set. Data can be relied upon to be the most current, accurate data available.

All charts are interactive and allow you to expand and filter data. We encourage you to check out the graph navigation link on the site for an overview of how to use the various charts.

Check back often as new charts are being added on a regular basis.
