# 10 Week Clinical Experience Pediatric Progression

# Week 1 - Orientation

Tour and review of expectations

Review of caseload and observation of treatment sessions

Assist in handling of equipment

Assist in selection of play activities/toys

Participate in handling techniques as directed by CI

Observe evaluation if available and write subjective portion of evaluation

Write at least 3 treatment notes by the end of the week

#### Week 2

Continued review of caseload and documentation specific for setting (IEP, IFSP, etc)

Create treatment plan for 25% non-complex patients with 75% guidance

Complete handling of equipment with 50% guidance

Select play activities/toys with 50% guidance

Complete interventions/handling techniques of non-complex patients with 75% guidance

Write at least 2 treatment notes each day this week with 50% guidance

Discuss goals for each patient with 75% guidance

#### Week 3

Perform subjective portion of evaluation if available with 25% guidance

Perform objective portion of evaluation if available with 50% guidance

Create treatment plan for 25% of non-complex patients with 50% guidance and 25% of complex patients with 75% guidance

Complete handling of all equipment with 25% guidance

Select play activities/toys with 25% guidance

Complete interventions/handling techniques of non-complex patients with 50% guidance and complex patients with 75%-100% guidance

Write at least 25% of the treatment notes each day this week with 25% guidance

Discuss goals for each patient with 50% guidance

# Week 4

Perform subjective portion of evaluation if available with 0-25% guidance

Perform objective portion of evaluation if available with 25% guidance

Create treatment plan for 75% of non-complex patients with 25% guidance and 25% of complex patients with 50% guidance

Complete handling of all familiar equipment with 0-25% guidance

Select play activities/toys with 0-25% guidance

Complete interventions/handling techniques of non-complex patients with 25% guidance and complex patients with 50-75% guidance

Write at least 50% of the treatment notes each day this week with 0-25% guidance

Discuss goals for each patient with 25% guidance

# Week 5

Perform complete evaluation if available of non-complex patient with no guidance

Perform complete evaluation if available of complex patient with 25% guidance

Create treatment plan for 100% of non-complex patients with 0-25% guidance and 50% of complex patients with 25% guidance

Complete handling of all familiar equipment with no guidance

Select play activities/toys with no guidance

Complete interventions/handling techniques of non-complex patients with 0-25% guidance and complex patients with 25-50% guidance

Write at least 75% of the treatment notes each day this week with 0-25% guidance

Discuss goals for each patient with 0-25% guidance

### Week 7

Perform complete evaluation if available of complex patient with 0-25% guidance

Create treatment plan for 100% of non-complex patients with no guidance and 75% of complex patients with 0-25% guidance

Complete interventions/handling techniques of non-complex patients with 0-25% guidance and complex patients with 25% guidance

Write 100% of the treatment notes each day this week independently

Discuss goals for each patient with 0-25% guidance

Maintain consistency of other skills met previously (equipment, play activities, etc)

# Week 8

Perform complete evaluation if available of complex patient independently

Create treatment plan for all patients independently

Complete interventions/handling techniques of non-complex patients independently and complex patients with 0-25% guidance

Maintain consistency of other skills met previously (equipment, play activities, etc)

# Weeks 9 and 10

Continuation/progression of week 8 activities with increased consistency in performance

Perform in the pediatric setting as expected for a new graduate who is newly employed

- \*\* Student should have continuous progress in communication with patient, caregivers, and other healthcare providers
- \*\* Student should have continuous progress in ability to relate to the child and create a welcoming and engaging environment
- \*\* Student should have continuous progress in managing behaviors and developing strategies in redirecting patient
