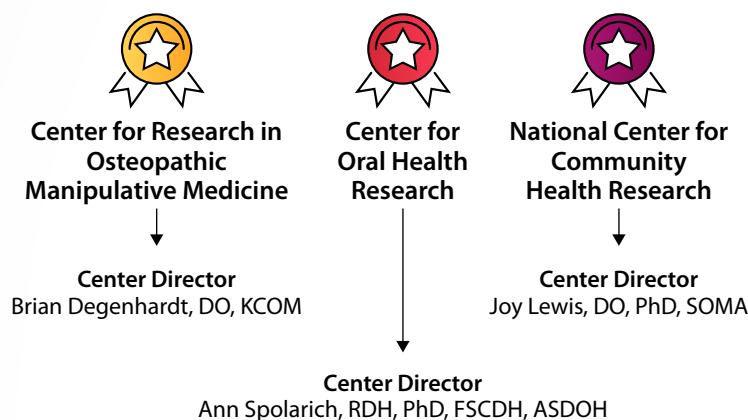


Institute Purpose & Goal

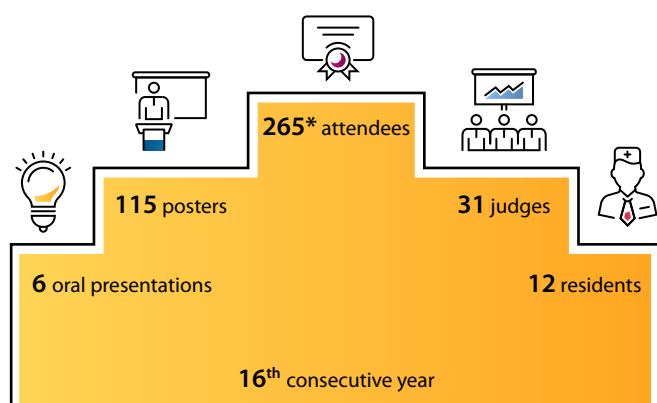

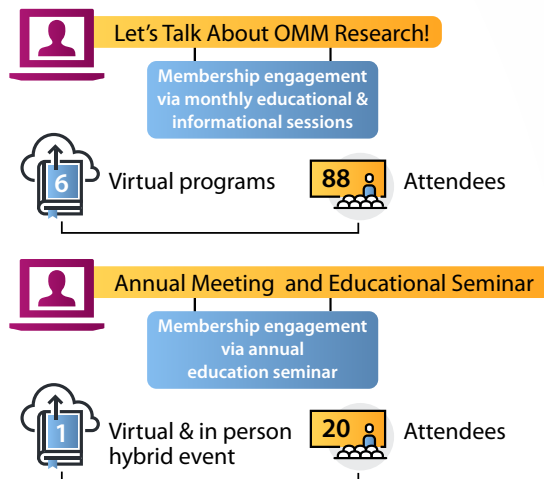
