OGME-1P, Preliminary Internship

This is the first year of training preliminary to residency training in specialties requiring a preliminary tracked internship year (Option 2). Educational content is set by the respective specialty colleges as approved by the AOA. OGME-1P trainees are supervised by the institutional intern program director. This is an internship year.
