



ATSU precautions

What should I do prior to arriving at an ATSU location?

Complete the health self-certification screening form daily by 7:00 a.m.

If you answered “Yes” to any question:

- Contact Student Affairs liaison or designated person at your college/school.
- Do not go to any ATSU location until cleared to do so.
- If sick or instructed to do so, contact your primary care physician.
If in Mesa, Arizona, also contact the COVID-19 Clearinghouse.

What precautions should I take on ATSU locations?

- Visit designated check-in area for temperature check before going to class/patient care centers.
If temperature is 100.0 F or higher, leave campus immediately.
- Wear a surgical/cloth mask covering your nose and mouth.
- For some activities, you may be required to wear eye protection or a face shield and additional PPE.
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water/antibacterial products.
- Maintain social/physical distancing.
- Do not congregate in classrooms, lounges, or other areas.
