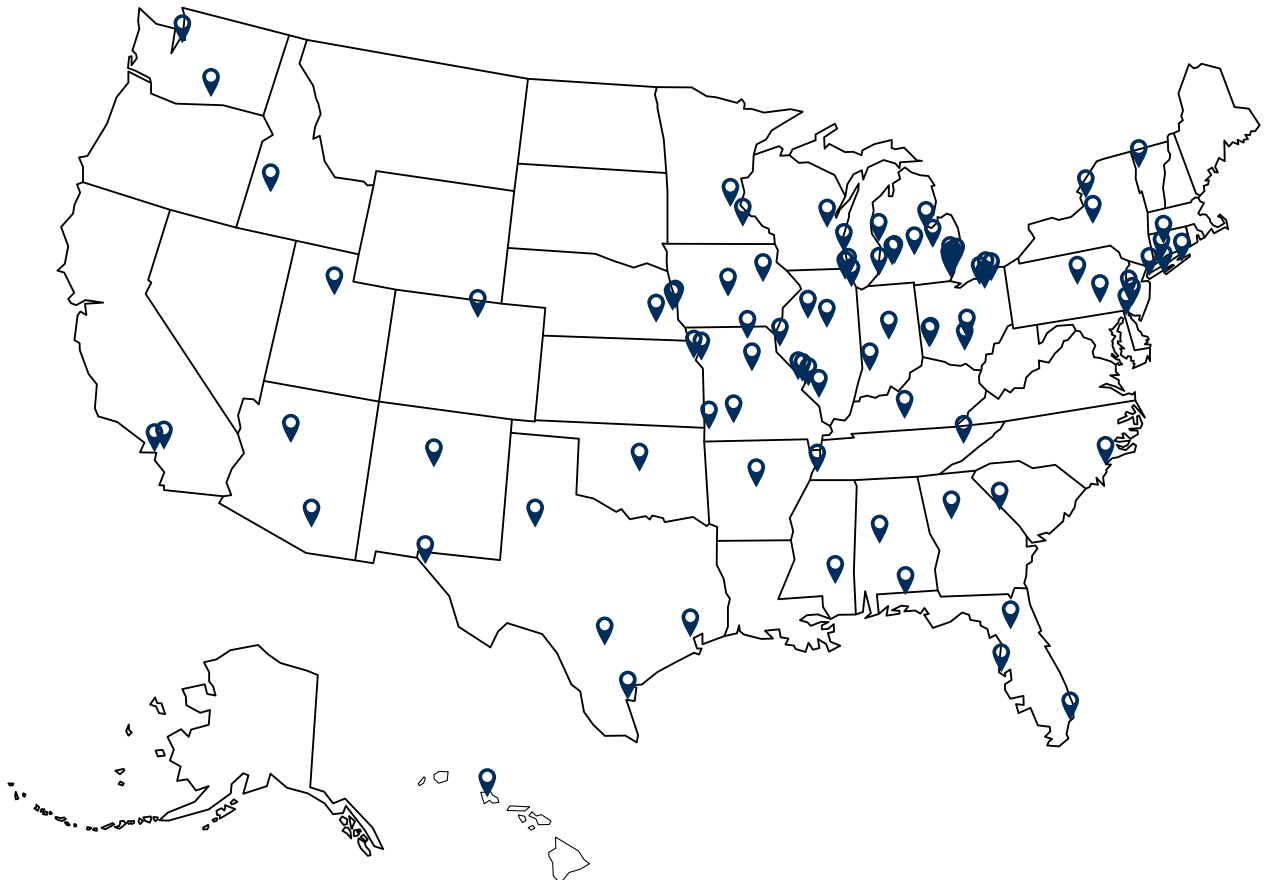

Educational content is set by the respective specialty colleges as approved by the AOA. OGME-1P trainees are supervised by the institutional intern program director. This is an internship year.
